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**Attention:** The letters *za* and *ra* denote *ḷ* and *ṛ*, respectively, of Tamil. Also note that *rṛa* sounds almost like *ṭra*, *rri* like *ṭri*, and so on. The consonant-cluster *nṛa* is pronounced somewhere between *nra* and *nḍra*. It is, however, colloquially acceptable to pronounce the clusters *rṛa* and *nṛa* as *tta* and *nna*, respectively.
